The purpose of this consultation will be to:

- Inform you regarding the issues of the legal recourse;
- Hear your thoughts and comments regarding this issue;
- Answer your questions;
- Provide us with the mandate to have the education rights of Francophones respected in Nunavut under the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms and proceed with a vote on this issue.
